

Sportsman / Sportswoman of the Year Award (2022/23) & <u>Alumni Association of Malaysia and Singapore Jubilee Prize</u>

A) Introduction

The Sportsman and Sportswoman of the Year Awards consist of a Trophy and a Trophy Replica. The Alumni Association of Malaysia and Singapore Jubilee Prizes are also awarded annually to the best undergraduate Sportsman and Sportswoman of the year.

B) Criteria for the Awards

The awards are to be bestowed upon students who have shown evidence of the following in the current year:

- The highest level of ability in their sport(s) at the national / regional / international level;
- Consistent and outstanding contribution to one or more University team(s) by participating in regular training and external competitions such as USFHK, AIG, World University Games, PRC University Games, National University Championship, etc.
- High standard of sportsmanship, conduct and leadership on and off the field of play.

C) Selection Procedures:

- 1. Centre of Sports and Exercise (CSE) would call for nomination from Sports Association and all Faculties, Halls and Club secretaries by means of the attached nomination form.
- *2.* Duly completed nomination forms should be returned to CSE by **<u>11 April, 2023 (Tue)</u>**. Once submitted, nomination forms cannot be amended, withdrawn or replaced. Late submission will not be accepted.
- 3. The Selection Committee, comprising CSE Director, Dean of Student Affairs and HKU SA President, will shortlist 4 nominees for the Sportsman and Sportswoman Award respectively and will then decide on the awardees.
- 4. Unless with prior approval from CSE, all shortlisted nominees will be required to attend the HKU Sports Team Superpass Gathering which will be held on 21st April (Friday) 2023.
- **5.** The results will be announced at the HKU Sports Team Superpass Dinner in which the award presentation will also take place.
